I developed this scholarship through Somewhere EDI, a Community Interest Company I founded in 2018. It is the first of its kind in Scotland and the second in the UK after The University of Cambridge. I went on to hire Teale as project manager for a new initiative from Somewhere: The Rainbow Enterprise Network. Soft launched in November 2020, REN aims to connect LGBT+ business owners, entrepreneurs and ally businesses to find support, solidarity and visibility in starting and sustaining their businesses. Teale is working with me to flesh out strategies, develop targets and assign duties based on the strengths and capabilities of our staff. She has written an impressive business plan to help me see where we are, where we want to go and how to get there.
